

Apply for Financial Aid 2010-2011



Don't wait! Complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) online at www.fafsa.ed.gov. Stay ahead of school and state financial aid deadlines by applying as soon as possible after January 1, 2010.

A step-by-step guide to apply:

Get Organized

- Gather together all the required documents to help simplify the application process. Some documents you'll need include your parents and/or your 2009 tax information, your social security number, and your driver's license. FAFSA's Web site tells you all the documents you'll need.
- Find the school code(s) of those school(s) that you want to receive your FAFSA information. There is an option to do this on the initial page or it can be done during the application process.
- Check application deadline dates as the deadline for your state or school may differ from federal deadlines.
- Apply for a Personal Identification Number (PIN) at www.pin.ed.gov. It's a fast and easy way to sign your FAFSA electronically and to correct your processed information online.

Complete Your Application

Once you're organized, filling out the FAFSA is easy. Make sure you click the "Submit" button, as your application is not complete until you do. Print out the confirmation page for your records.

Follow Up on Your FAFSA

Go to www.fafsa.ed.gov to

- check the status of your submitted FAFSA,
- make corrections to a processed FAFSA,
- add or delete school code(s), and/or
- view and print your Student Aid Report.



Returning students can use the same Web site, www.pin.ed.gov, to have your existing pin re-sent.
